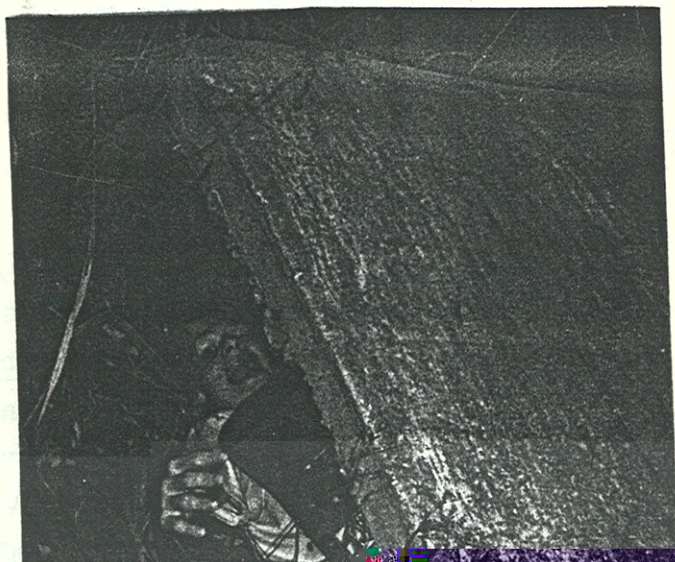

ice tea mix (Troy's love)

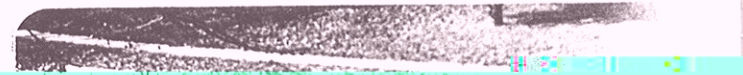
Upon tasting the original recipe Dan Brown, at Wiggys jam, spit it out and almost puked! Some like it some don't lol





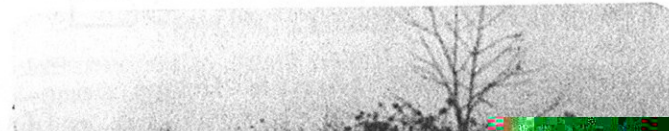
## THE DITCH RAMP

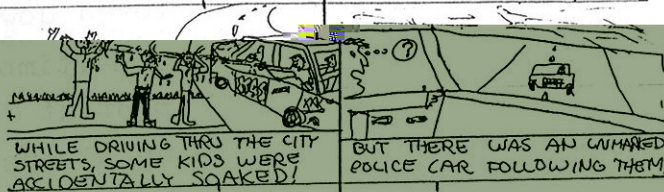
## CONSULTIN MR. WEBSTER

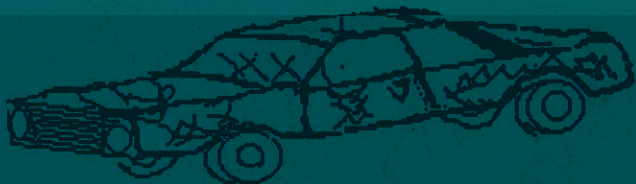

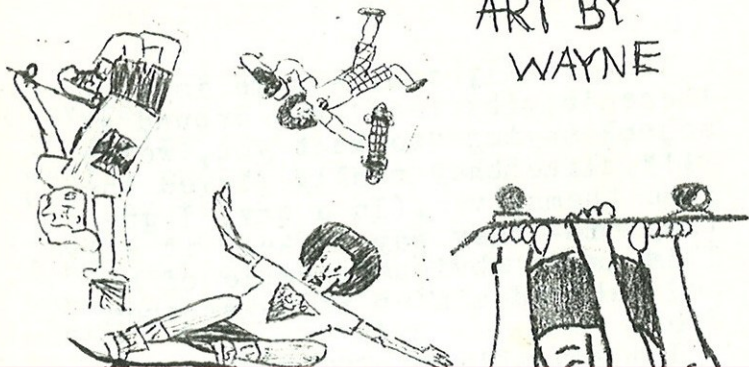
## WHY I HATE SPECTATOR SPORTS

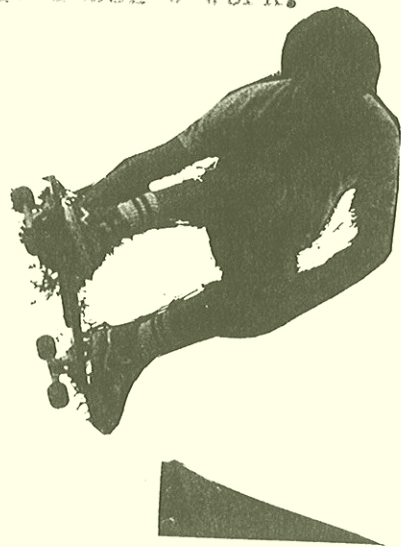
